

Do your application right


First up, read the information given carefully and thoroughly. Assume the selection committee has no prior knowledge of your intended course of study, so give all the details possible.

Imagine the selection committee dealing with hundreds of applications, so make the information as accessible as possible.

Beyond the information provided, there are few guidelines. You need to use your best judgement – anticipate the information requested and the reason the information is requested. The project officer's personal judgement is as good as yours. They are not the selection committee. You need to anticipate and present the information required. Beyond the information you have, there are no absolutes. Good judgement and initiative are

essential to being successful in winning a scholarship.

Deadlines are set for reason. Beyond your application deadline lie a series of deadlines in the process of deciding the final recipients.

Include all requested documents and the copies requested in one pack. Assume you are up against a lot of other applicants. If everyone just faxed or posted in one page late – imagine the chaos. How would your lecturer respond if half of the people in your course sent in one part of their essay late and expected the lecturer to compile their essay. Send your application in one complete pack.
