The ANU Legal Workshop provides a flexible alternative for direct admission in Victoria. From 2008 the ANU Legal Workshop will hold its Skills Intensive course three times per year in Victoria. After completion of the Skills Intensive students can continue the course work online.

The majority of Legal Workshop students choose the flexible online

course delivery, allowing them to continue with their current employment.

Once completed choose either Graduate Diploma of Legal Practice transfer to the ANU LLM and receive credit towards the Masters.

If you are in your final year of law studies, you may also consider concurrent enrolment to get an early start on your practical legal training.
