Aerospace scholarship

The society created its Centennial Scholarship Fund in tribute to the achievements of the first century of powered flight, with the aim of giving financial support to those who have the ability and determination to make a significant contribution to the second century of powered flight.



Studying detention

Monash PhD student Azadeh Dastyari, has won a Fulbright Postgraduate Alumni (WG Walker) Scholarship.

Dastyari will conduct a comparative study of US and Australian immigration and refugee law at Georgetown University starting in September this year.

Her research will examine the

interception, detention and offshore processing of asylum seekers by Australia at Christmas Island, Nauru and Papua New Guinea and the US in Guantanamo Bay, Cuba.

"My research will also examine the implications of the recently signed Memorandum of Understanding between Australia and the US which means each country now has a vested interest in the other's offshore processing regime," Dastyari explains.

The prestigious Fulbright program is the largest educational scholarship of its kind, created by US Senator J. William Fulbright and the US Government in 1946. Aimed at promoting mutual understanding through educational exchange, it operates between the US and 150 countries. In Australia, the scholarships are funded by the Australian and US Governments and administered by the Australian-American Fulbright Commission in Canberra.
