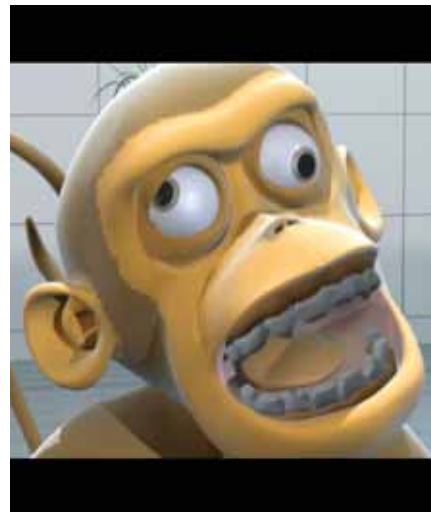


## Work can be a game

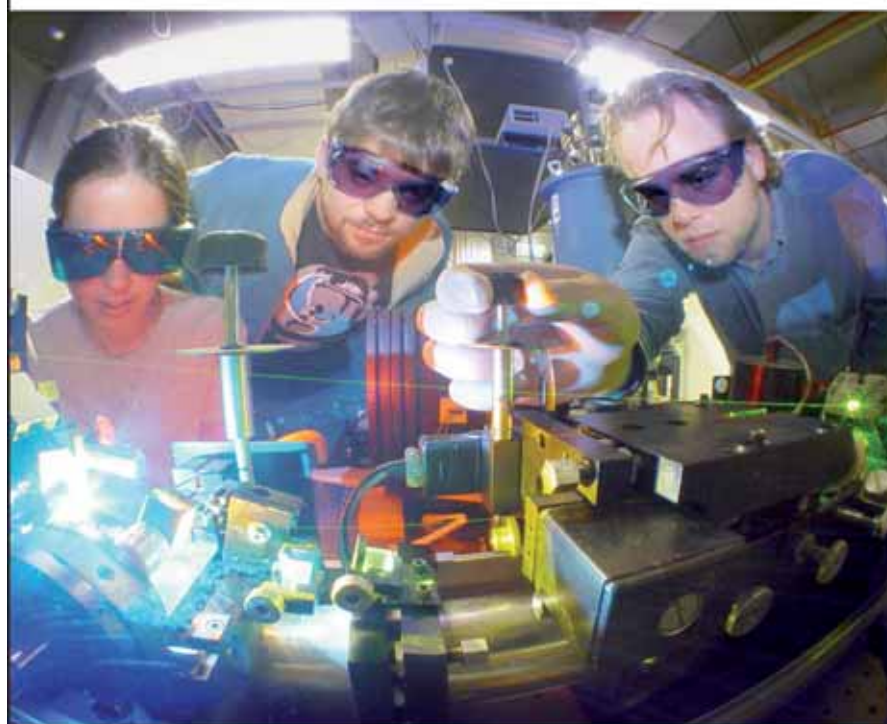
