

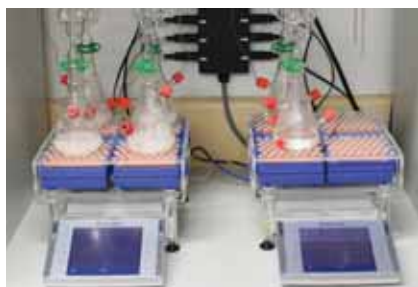
Ready for take off?

Associate Professor Vladimir Jiranek and his team at the Uni of Adelaide have been working on how to improve one of the world's favourite beverages, wine. The team is currently using many cutting edge techniques to interrogate what is actually going on during fermentation, including fermentation analysis of candidate gene manipulations with their multi-scaled, high throughput fermentation facility (pictured), adaptive evolution, genomics and metabolomics.
