Learn to film

Now in its fifteenth year, the Filmmaking Summer School, part of the University of Melbourne's Screen Studies Program, offers intensive teaching in all aspects of film production. Each day or session is taught by Australia's leading film industry practitioners in their area of expertise. The course, open to aspiring filmmakers of any age, is designed to cover the essential skills, basic knowledge and industry insight needed to make films, knowledge that would normally require years of experience to acquire, and will equip participants with the confidence, knowledge and skills to start a career in film or television and translate their own ideas and visions to the screen. The teaching course *From Script to Screen*, can be taken in full (19 days), in part (15 days) or as an introductory course (10 days) or participants can choose their own days and make up their own course. Extra courses at the 2009 summer school are the two day documentary course, the four day cinematography intensive and to encourage new writers, a four day 'Writer's Block' of specialist writing days taught by some of the best screenwriters.
