

Monash wins Unigames

After a week of intense competition early last month, Monash took top spot by 13 points over the University of Melbourne. The University of Sydney came third.

The Australian University Games, held in Melbourne this year for the first time in 10 years, are Australia's largest annual multi-sport event.

7000 participants converged on 31 Melbourne sporting venues during the five days of competition. Representing 42 universities across 28 sports, the 2008 Unigames included a diverse group of athletes ranging from beginners to elite Olympians.

2009 will see the Australian University Games held on Queensland's Gold Coast.
